Type of CPD	Activities
<p><b>Type 1 – Facilitated learning</b></p> <p>There is <b>no limit</b> to the maximum number of hours that you can claim over a three year period for these activities</p>	<p>Tertiary study  Short courses  Workshops  Seminars  Conferences  Webinars  Technical inspections that are facilitated  Technical meetings that are facilitated</p>
<p><b>Type 2 – Unfacilitated learning</b></p> <p>A <b>maximum of 120 hours</b> of your total CPD in any three year period may be claimed for these activities</p>	<p>Learning activities in the workplace that extends knowledge and skills such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Feasibility studies</li> <li>• Learning new standards including new revisions</li> <li>• Learning new software including new revisions</li> <li>• Learning new markets and their requirements</li> </ul> <p>Private study that keeps you informed of current practice and extends knowledge and skills such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Books</li> <li>• Journals</li> <li>• Pod casts</li> </ul>
<p><b>Type 3 – Service to the corrosion profession</b></p> <p>If you have <b>at least 15 years practical experience</b> you can <b>claim up to 50 hours</b> of your total CPD in any three year period for these activities</p> <p>If you have <b>at least 30 years practical experience</b> you can <b>claim up to 75 hours</b> of your total CPD in any three year period for these activities</p> <p>If you have <b>over 30 years practical experience</b> you can <b>claim up to 100 hours</b> of your total CPD in any three year period for these activities</p>	<p>Preparation and presentation of material for conferences, seminars, webinars, and courses – up to 45 hours per paper. This represents work outside your normal employment and contributes to the advancement of the corrosion profession.</p> <p>Reviewing technical publications prior to publication.</p> <p>Serving as a volunteer on committees, technical groups etc of the ACA.</p> <p>Serving on as a volunteer on boards and committees which advance the corrosion profession.</p> <p>Being an interviewer on a certification assessment panel.</p> <p>Mentoring.</p> <p>Assisting with CPD audits.</p>
